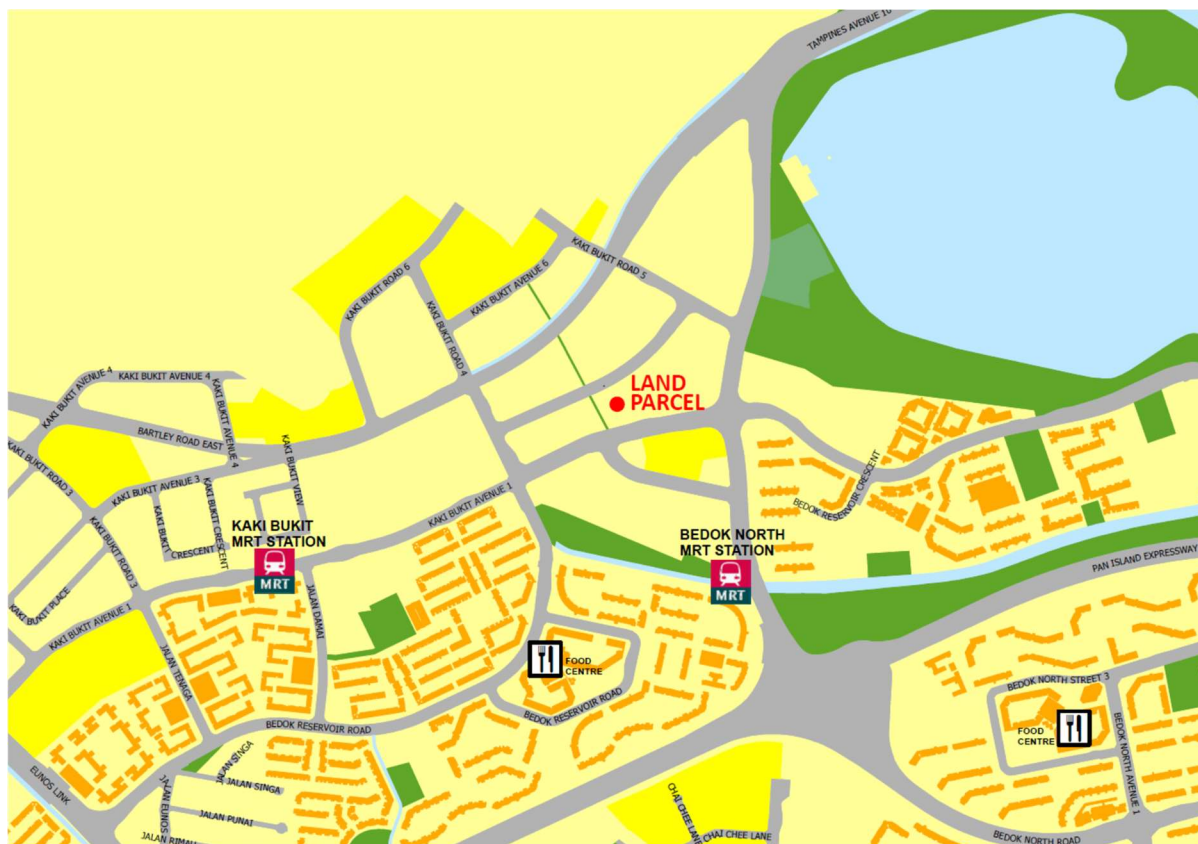


JTC Sale of Site Industrial Development

LAND PARCEL @ KAKI BUKIT



CHOICE LOCATION

The land parcel is strategically located near well-established industrial estates such as Shun Li Industrial Park. Businesses and employees will enjoy close proximity to amenities such as Kaki Bukit Amenity Centre and Kaki Bukit Recreation Centre as well as recreational facilities such as Bedok Reservoir.

EXCELLENT CONNECTIVITY

The land parcel is easily accessible from the Pan Island Expressway (PIE) and well-connected via major arterial roads like Kaki Bukit Road 5 and Bedok Reservoir Road, providing seamless connectivity to other parts of the island. Commuters are also well-served by Bedok North and Kaki Bukit MRT stations.

2. Submission of Tender

Any tender submitted after 11:00 am on the tender submission date will not be considered.

3. Tender Deposit

Every tenderer shall pay a tender deposit of at least five percent (5%) of the tendered sale price.

The tender deposit mentioned in Condition 12 of the Conditions of Tender ("Tender Deposit") may be paid by any one or more of the following methods:

- Bank Transfer
- Electronic Guarantee

Payment in CASH or by CHEQUE or any other means WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Please refer to

the Conditions of Tender for detailed requirement.

The Tender Deposit will be returned to all unsuccessful tenderers.

The Tender Deposit shall be forfeited if the tenderer withdraws his tender during the Tender Validity Period.

Tenders submitted without the Tender Deposit will be disqualified.

4. Acceptance of Tender

Tenders shall remain valid for acceptance for ten (10) weeks from the said date of submission of tenders. However, JTC may by notice in writing to each tenderer extend the validity period of his tender by such further period not exceeding two (2) weeks.

JTC reserves the right to reject the highest bid price or any tender or any part thereof.

5. Payment of Sale Price

The Successful Tenderer shall pay the bid sale price as follows:-

- 25% (less the Tender Deposit) and GST on 25% of the bid sale price within twenty-eight (28) days from the date of JTC's acceptance of this tender; and the 28 days shall include the date of JTC's acceptance.
- 75% and the GST thereon within ninety (90) days of acceptance of this tender; and the 90 days shall include the date of JTC's acceptance.
