AMENDMENT TO JTC'S PRACTICE CIRCULAR DATED 6 AUGUST 2001 – ENVIRONMENTAL BASELINE STUDY (EBS) FOR TRANSFER/ASSIGNMENT OF LEASE

- 1. We refer to our Practice Circular dated 6 August 2001 on the above subject.
- 2. Please inform your members that with effect from **1 December 2002**, the provisional list of pollutive industries/activities which have potential to cause land pollution contained in Annex A of that Practice Circular shall be superceded by the following provisional list of industries/activities:
  - a) Oil installations and other premises storing, handling and using large quantities of oils and similar hydrocarbons products, including the following
    - Oil refineries;
    - Oil depots;
    - Petrochemical complexes;
    - · Petrol stations and refueling depots;
    - · Aircraft manufacture and repair industries;
    - Motor repair workshops.
  - b) Chemical plants, chemical warehouses or terminals including the following
    - Chemical warehouses or terminals;
    - Pharmaceutical/biomedical plants;
    - · Pesticides formulation factories;
    - Wood treatment and preservation facilities;
    - Large electroplating works;
    - Factories that use, manufacture or store toxic chemicals.
  - c) Shipyards and grit blasting works
  - d) Gas works
  - e) Power stations

- f) Toxic wastes treatment facilities
- g) Scrap yards
- h) Landfill site for municipal or industrial wastes
- i) Facilities for the treatment of sewage

The provisional list above is also subject to change.
