JTC will also be partnering with Enterprise Singapore, under the Global Innovation Alliance (GIA) initiative, to strengthen support for Launchpad startups expanding into new markets. 2. LaunchPad Innovation Network (LINK)

JTC's LaunchPad Innovation Network (LINK) will now reflect a broader mandate: connecting LaunchPad startups with corporates, investors, and strategic partners to unlock market opportunities and commercialisation support. The expanded scope goes beyond funding, strengthening LaunchPad's role as a gateway for startups to scale globally while anchoring their growth in Singapore's innovation ecosystem.
